OR

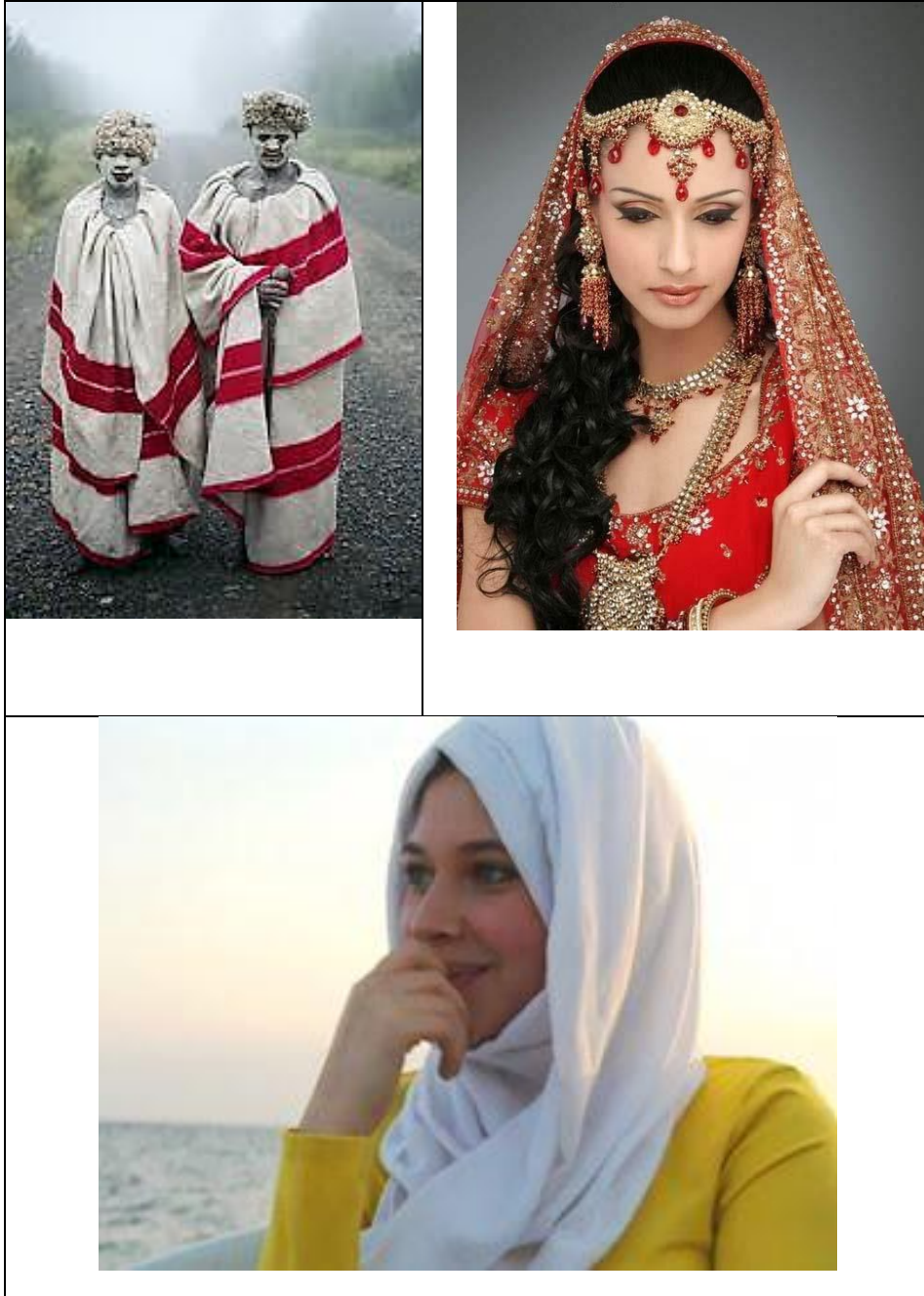
1.6 Why I like/dislike fashionable clothing. **[50]**

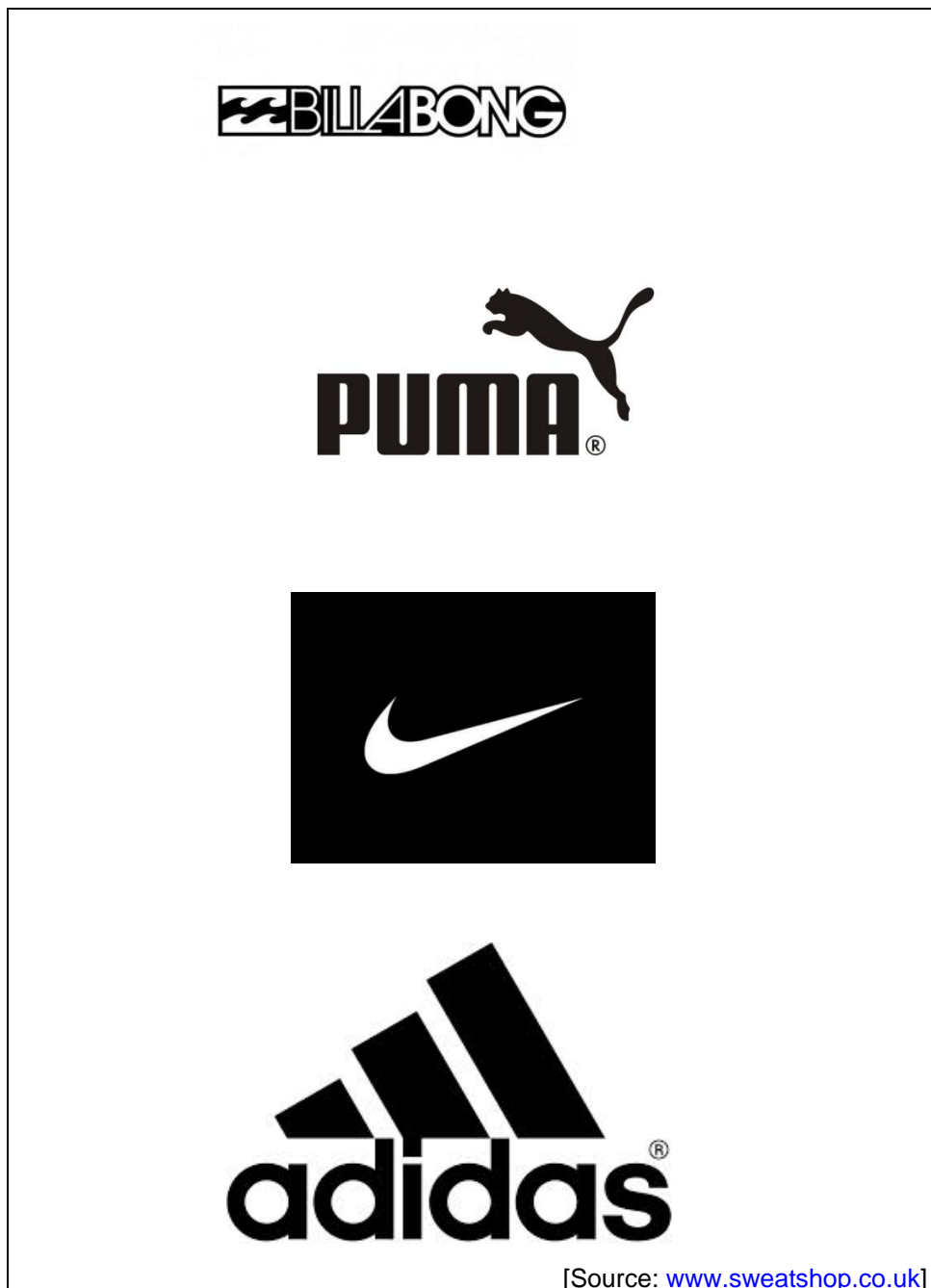
