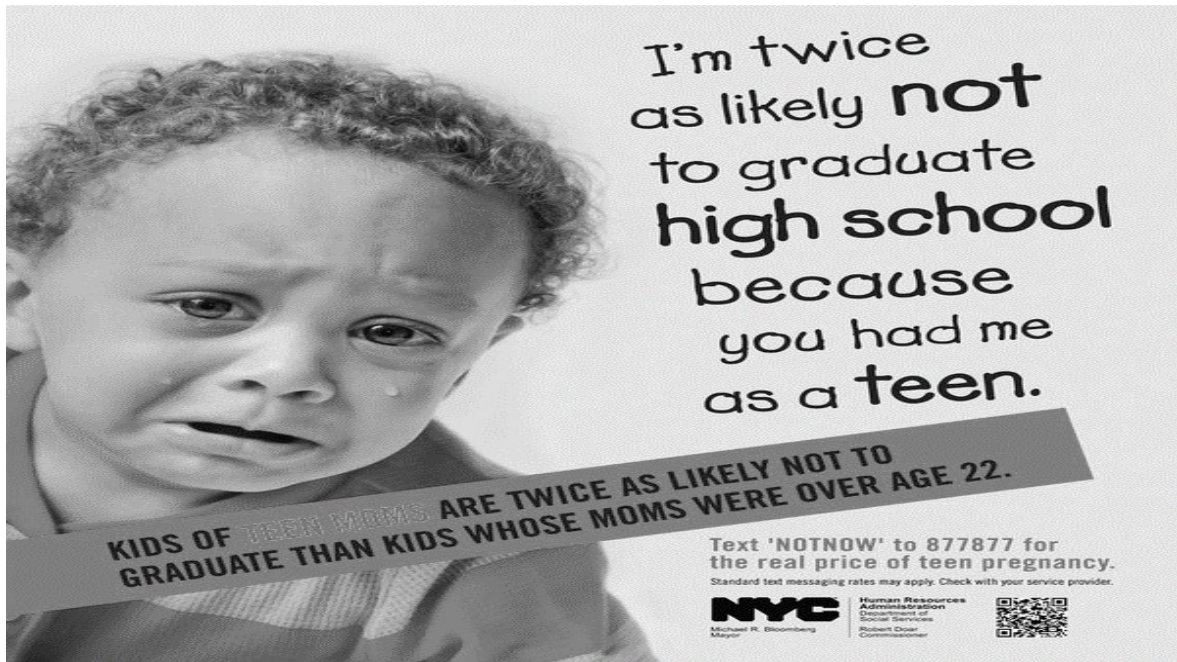

2.1.1 Identify **THREE** reasons for teenage pregnancy. (3x1)(3)

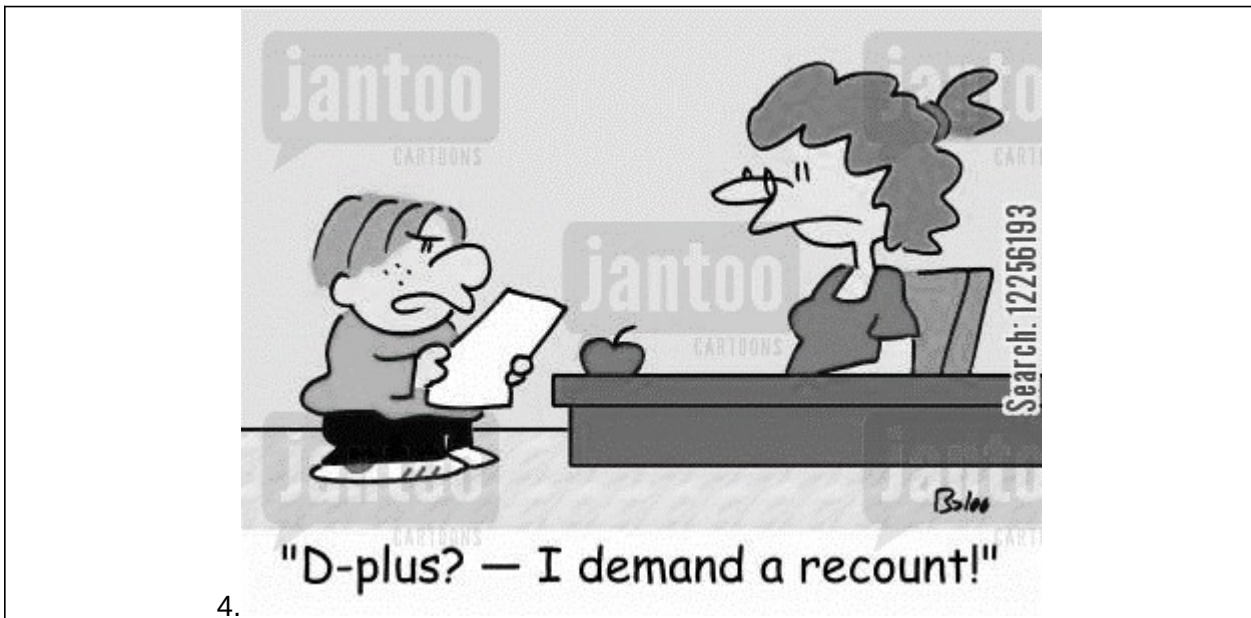
2.1.2 Indicate **TWO** ways in which substance abuse can contribute to teenage pregnancies. (2x1)(2)
