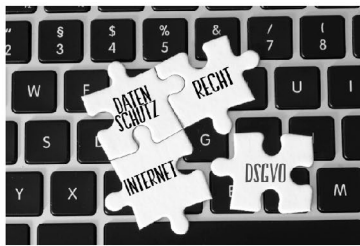

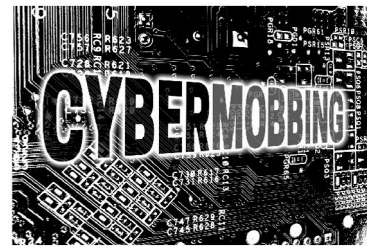

- During the 15 minutes' preparation time, you are required to prepare **two** stimulus cards. You will be asked to choose your first card from two on one sub-theme and then you must choose one of the other two cards the teacher-examiner gives you.
- You may make notes during the preparation time only on the Additional Answer Sheet provided. **You must not write on the cards.**
- You should take the stimulus cards with you into the examination room. You may refer to the cards and any notes you have made at any time during the test.
- You should hand the stimulus cards and the Additional Answer Sheet to the teacher-examiner at the end of the test.

Information

- The test will last between 12 and 14 minutes and will consist of **two** stimulus cards (6–7 minutes each).
- The teacher-examiner will ask the questions exactly as they are printed on the cards and may ask follow-up questions to develop the discussion of the sub-themes.
- You must ask the teacher-examiner one question arising from the material on each card. You can ask the question at any time during the discussion of the card.
- To develop the discussion of the sub-themes, you will be expected to respond to questions and discuss in **German** broader issues within the sub-themes on the cards.
- You must **not** use a dictionary at any time during this test. This includes the preparation time.

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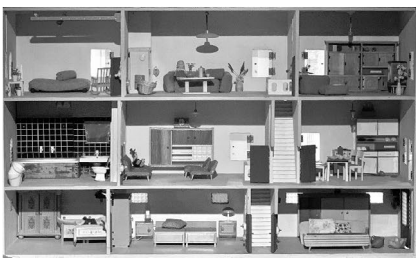
