- Apples
- Bread

## Question 4

Criteria	Marks

### **Sample answer:**

School leavers who are looking for an alternative way to celebrate the end of school are likely to be interested.

It also would appeal to adventurous young people who like exploring tropical forests and going camping.

### **Sample answer:**

It is difficult for her to make a decision because on the one hand she would like to help the boss who needs her to work an extra shift on Sunday (which would be double pay). On the other hand, she hasn't had a Sunday off in weeks and she wants to go to yoga.

**Sample answer:**

Paolo learns that Sara doesn't like soccer. She loves motorbikes and cars. She wants to become a professional Formula One driver.

**Sample answer:**

Adamo wants to go on a surfing holiday because it's a great way to keep fit and enjoy yourself at the same time. Melissa prefers the country. She believes that the water is too cold and she is scared of being attacked by sharks. Furthermore, she admits she's never surfed and can't swim. They agree on going to a hotel in the country.

## Question 8

• Provides some details of the consequences of Giacomo's decision with reference to the text	2

**Sample answer:**

Giacomo decided not to wear his glasses. As a result, the date with Elisa did not happen/Elisa was upset. Since he decided not to wear his glasses he was not able to see or read well. He picked up the wrong phone, he caught the wrong bus, and went into the wrong restaurant. Consequently, he did not meet up with his date. He also ordered a very expensive glass of wine because he couldn't read the prices on the menu.

**Sample answer:**

Olivia is likely to receive tickets to a rock concert because she loves music. It's her dream to go to one as she has never been before. Furthermore, her favourite band is going to be playing next month. Although the tickets are expensive, the speakers agree she deserves them as she has also received very good marks at school and helps her brothers.

### Question 11 (a)

**Sample answer:**

Because he and his family are visiting his grandparents for Christmas and to ski.

### Question 11 (b)

**Sample answer:**

His parents want him to celebrate New Year at home with them which he thinks is boring. He wants to go to a club, but his parents don't agree/won't let him.

### Question 11 (c)

**Sample answer:**

To work as a ski instructor.

### Question 12 (a)

**Sample answer:**

Raffaella is excited about tonight because she's going out on a date with Jamie and she can't wait to go dancing with him in her new shoes.

**Question 12 (b)**

• Provides a sound explanation of Raffaella's dilemma about the job offer	3
• Provides some explanation of Raffaella's dilemma about the job offer	2
• Provides some relevant information	1

**Sample answer:**

On the one hand, this job requires Raffaella to commit every afternoon for 2 hours, but she needs to focus on her studies as she's worried about her final grades. On the other hand, she will be paid well for the babysitting job and she needs the money for her gap year travelling through Europe. Adding to her dilemma, she also loves this job and she believes it may give her the right experience as she wants to be a preschool teacher.

**Question 13**

• Demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of how likely Noemi is to rent the house advertised with detailed reference to the text	5
• Demonstrates a thorough understanding of how likely Noemi is to rent the house advertised with reference to the text	4
• Demonstrates a sound understanding of how likely Noemi is to rent the house advertised with some reference to the text	3
• Identifies some reasons why Noemi may or may not rent the advertised house	2
• Provides some relevant information	1

**Sample answer:**

It is not at all likely that Noemi will rent this house because she wants an apartment for a month, not two weeks. Although the public transport would suit them because they don't have a car, they don't want to be so far away from the city centre of Florence. Furthermore, they only need a small apartment, while the house is very big. They don't need a kitchen because they want to eat out and they don't want to cook. They also want to sleep in, but the birds would wake them up. Even though pets are allowed it is very unlikely that Noemi will choose this house.

At 8:30 am or at least 15 minutes before the train departs at 8:45 am, in front of the ticket office at (Vinci) station.

**Sample answer:**

To Do	Reason
Bring money/arrive 15 mins early	To purchase a train ticket

Bring letters	To thank the ambassador

They will have a special lunch and also receive their certificate and a prize. There will be a special screening of their movie and the students will be able to take a tour of the building.
