**Sample answer:**

Katina has missed the bus because she was waiting for her friend to drop off her book which she needs for school.

### Question 5

• Demonstrates a thorough understanding of why Martha is frustrated with her brother	3

**Sample answer:**

Martha is frustrated with her brother because he always goes back on his word. Although he had promised that she could watch her movie today, he is now refusing to let her and refuses to discuss it. She is frustrated with his attitude because he always gets his way.

**Sample answer:**

**Sample answer:**

The activities offered by the hotel include: going for a boat ride and seeing the natural beauty of the island, savouring the local cuisine, a walking trip to the mountains to enjoy the beautiful views. And finally, a bus trip to a winery to see how wine is made.

**Sample answer:**

Maria is very relaxed and does not stress about being late. She is often late for outings with friends but this does not concern her, and she is unlikely to change her ways. She is inflexible and stubborn.

Whereas Louka is anxious and stressed because they will once again be late for the match. He is very forgiving, accommodating and is prepared to compromise.

**Sample answer:**

**Sample answer:**

He is very likely to follow the advice given – that he works for his father for a period of six months as an electrician and gain some experience. This may secure him a position at TAFE and will allow him to decide whether this really is the career he wants to pursue. As well he will be earning some money and in the future there is the possibility that he will take over his father's company.

### Question 12 (b)

**Sample answer:**

The mother's reaction is justified as she is angry with her daughter who always leaves things to the last minute and who texts her knowing that she is at work and is not able to help her.

### Question 13

• Demonstrates a thorough understanding of who would find this advertisement appealing with reference to the text	4
• Demonstrates a sound understanding of who would find this advertisement appealing with some reference to the text	3

**Sample answer:**

Those who would find this advertisement appealing are fed up with their daily, monotonous routine. Those who want to experience a variety of physical activities and those who want to relax in a peaceful setting. Also those who want to take advantage of the cheaper deal.

### Question 14 (a)

**Sample answer:**

Vangelis is concerned about his sister and wants advice on how to handle the situation.

### Question 14 (b)

• Demonstrates some understanding of whose advice he is likely to follow with reference to the text	2
• Provides some relevant information	1

**Sample answer:**

Vangelis is likely to follow Amalia's advice as she is more caring. She acknowledges that Vangelis's position is difficult but she feels that the best way to approach this is to speak to his sister and to be honest about his concerns.

Petros's advice, however, is not as helpful as it does not address Vangelis's concerns. He believes that Vangelis should leave his sister alone and let her learn from her mistakes. He also believes that interference could jeopardise his friendship with Strato.

### Question 15 (a)

The article was written to raise the issue about a new government law that bans the use of mobile phones during school time and to present two points of view.

**Sample answer:**

At first, the mother is enthusiastic about the new law and believes students should not be contacted during class time. However, she believes that given the dangers in today's society she should be able to contact her children should the need arise.

Harry is very pleased with the new law. He feels that it will minimise the many disruptions in the classroom as well as encourage more active interactions in the playground. He also feels that this may put an end to some of the negative use of mobiles phones.

**Sample answer:**

Matina has matured and seen the errors of her ways, and has decided to do something worthwhile with her life. This was triggered when she encountered her old teacher accidentally and felt shame as he had always believed in her ability. She is not materialistic and is more concerned with job satisfaction. She is caring as she wants to help others less fortunate than herself.
